# Did You Know?

- The University has more than **300 active collaborations with more than 200 community partner agencies** to help alleviate urgent community needs, enrich lives, and improve our City and region.
- As home to the region's **only academic medical center**, the University of Rochester Medical Center is also the leading source of new physicians in the area and the safety-net provider for our most vulnerable citizens.
- Since 2015, the **University's partnership with East High School has doubled graduation rates**, dramatically reduced suspensions and dropouts, and created stronger academic programs that have enabled increased student achievement.
- The University of Rochester is committed to meeting the full demonstrated need of all admitted students. In the last four years alone, the University has provided more than **\$3.7 million in scholarships to Rochester City School District graduates who earned admission to the College**.
- With significant support from New York State and the federal government, the University invested \$16 million to establish **NextCorps**, a regional business incubator, as the anchor of the City's Downtown Innovation Zone and the \$200 million redevelopment of the Sibley Building. NextCorps currently supports **65 high-tech startup companies** and the **world's largest business accelerator for optics, photonics and imaging startups**.
- For more than 50 years, **Eastman Dental's SMILEmobiles** have provided dental treatment to children and adults who otherwise would not receive care. Today, the program serves uninsured and underinsured children in 15 city schools and three Head Start programs, and in total, has served **39,000 children**.
- The School of Nursing provides free and comprehensive physical and mental health services at its **School-Based Health Centers** at East High School and the Frederick Douglass Campus in the City of Rochester. More than **4,500 patient visits** are provided each year for students in grades 6 through 12 at the schools.
- The internationally renowned **Eastman School of Music** has invested more than **\$50 million over the last decade to renovate and expand its presence in downtown Rochester**.
- Thanks to nearly **\$1.5 million in University support**, **more than 500 employees have purchased their first home in the City** as a result of the University's **Home Ownership Incentive Program**—a partnership between the City of Rochester, the University and several banks and credit unions. In 2017, as part of the Rochester-Monroe Anti-Poverty Initiative, the University expanded the program to the Beechwood, EMMA, and Marketview Heights neighborhoods.
- The University's **5,000 undergraduates spend 35,000 collective service hours** each year in the Rochester community.
- **Mt. Hope Family Center**, a University of Rochester affiliate, is dedicated to reducing the impact of childhood trauma and provides evidence-based intervention and prevention services to over 900 at-risk children and families annually.
